The Coastal Bend Texas Chapter of the American Red Cross (Corpus Christi, TX) is proud to announce the fourth annual ERV Road-E-O and Training Institute. The event will be held at the Richard M. Borchard Regional Fairgrounds, 1213 Terry Shamsie Blvd, Robstown, TX, March 17– 22, 2014.

The past ERV Road-E-O and Training Institutes were attended by volunteers and staff from across the state of Texas, Oklahoma, Louisiana and several other states. This year's event will be bigger and better! The training institute this year will offer almost **ALL** basic Red Cross classes as well as several intermediate and advanced classes. Several of the classes being offered are very difficult to obtain. There will be offerings for everyone from brand new volunteers to well experienced managers! Not a Red Cross volunteer? We can take care of that situation as well!

The ERV Road-E-O will allow ERV crews to demonstrate their individual abilities as well as the team work of the crew. There will be a number of obstacles setup for drivers to negotiate and be judged on as well as ERV inspections. How many obstacles and what type? Last year there were multiple obstacles that included straight driving, a serpentine course, parallel parking, diminishing clearance, loading dock parking, 3 point turn and 90 degree turns. And, to make it interesting forward and reverse plus left and right variations were included. This year ... well you'll just have to attend! Awards will be presented to the best crews and the best individual drivers along with runners-up. If a participant needs an ERV to drive we'll have plenty and if a participant needs a partner to make a team we can also remedy that situation. The proposed schedule of events is shown later in this document. National Fleet Operations has authorized all Texas, Oklahoma and Louisiana ERVs to participate and will pay the fuel costs! Chapter owned ERVs will also be allowed to compete. The associated costs of moving any Chapter owned equipment will be the responsibility of the home Chapter.

Many of the meals will be provided. A staff shelter will be established for all participants. The staff shelter will open on Sunday, March 16, 2014 for early arrivals. There are many motels nearby if you prefer to use them but that will be at your individual cost. There is RV parking available at the fairgrounds. The nightly rate is \$20.00 and includes water and electric – also your cost. A dump station is available for your use.

While you're here you may want to take advantage of one of the major Texas tourist attractions, Corpus Christi! Tour the 'Lexington' (a WW II aircraft carrier, a.k.a. 'The Grey Ghost'), visit the famous Texas State Aquarium, check out the museums, and, don't forget the gorgeous Gulf of Mexico with beautiful beaches and water sports of all kinds. Maybe take a drive "down island" to the picturesque Padre Island National Seashore located just a few miles down Park Road 22 or visit Port Aransas and watch the dolphins play in the waves. The Corpus Christi area is also a world-renowned fishing area. Speckled Trout, Red Drum, Flounder, Black Drum, Tarpon and various Snappers are just a few of the species lurking in our waters.
